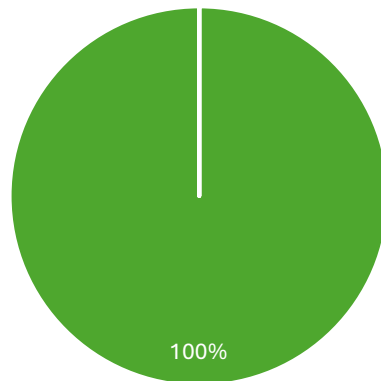

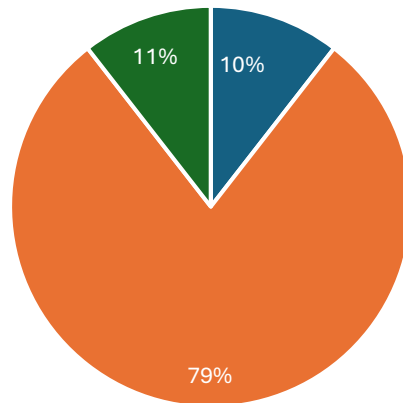

Gender Identity



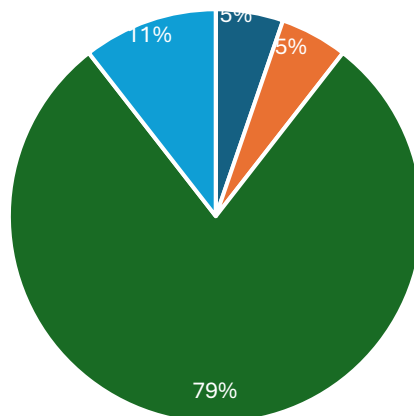

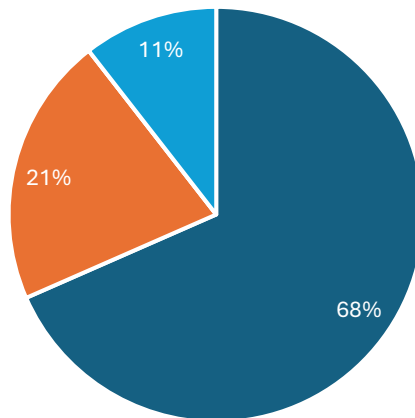

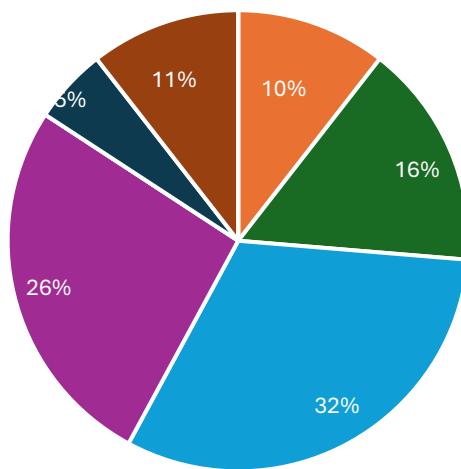

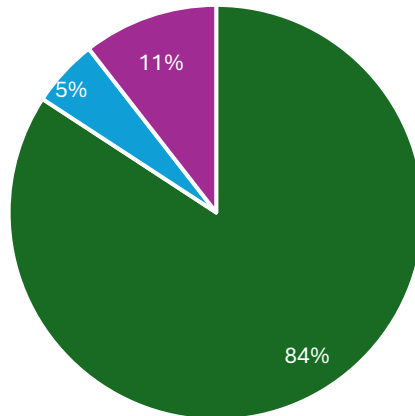

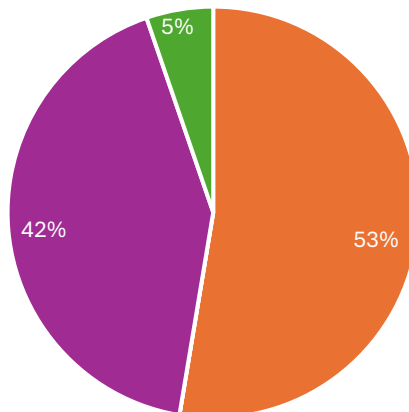

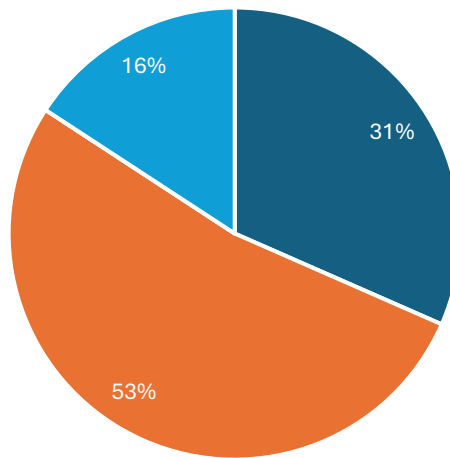

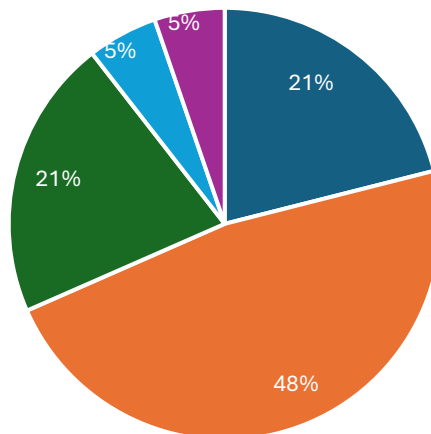
